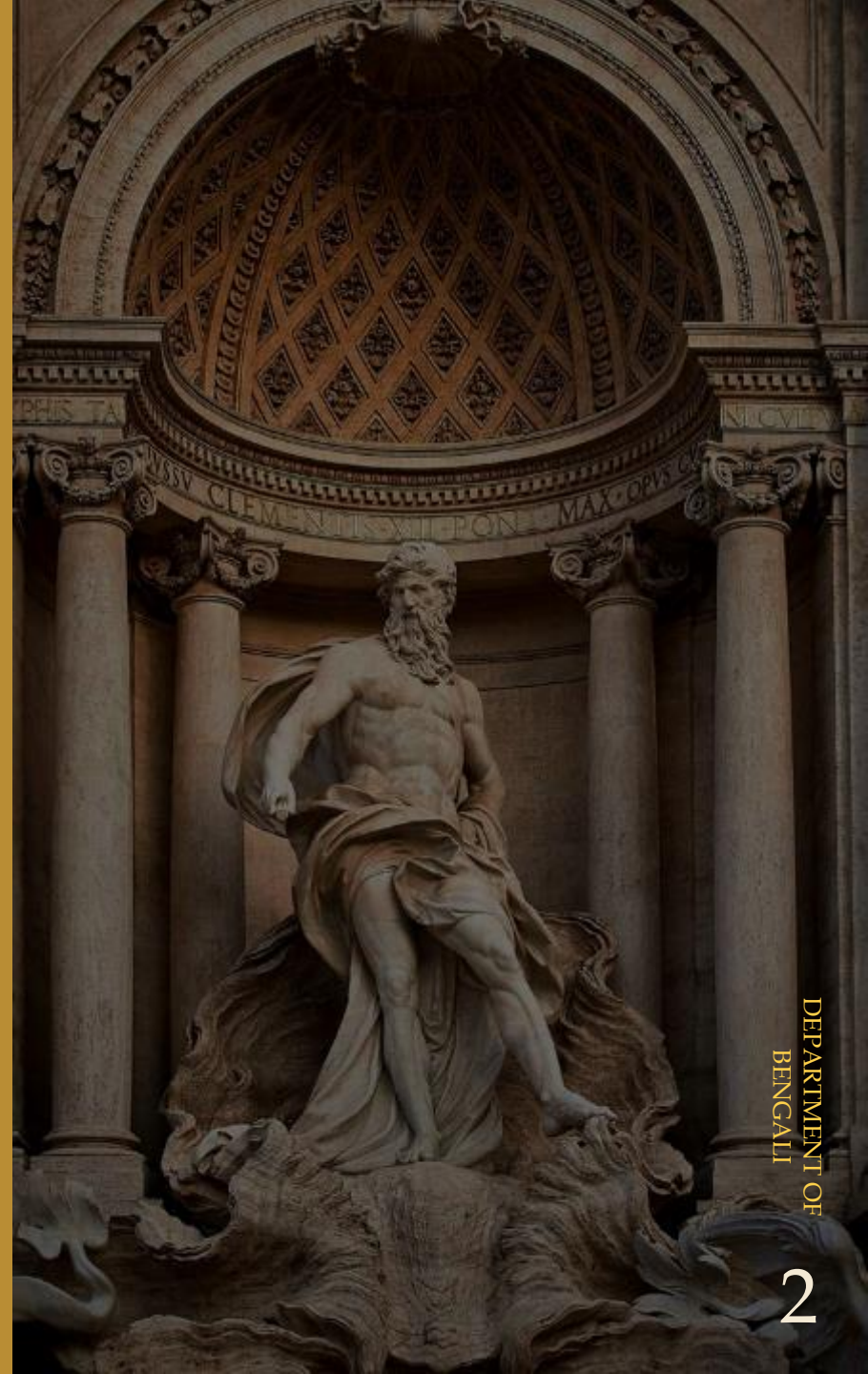


### Submissions of Scholarly Articles:
