

History of the College

Hetampur village in the Birbhum district of West Bengal. It is the oldest college in the district, creating an atmosphere of learning and pedagogy for the first time in this area. It was founded by Maharani Padma Sundari Devi, the wife of Maharaja Ramranjan Chakraborty, in the name of her father-in-law, Raja Krishna Chandra. Before formally starting its operations, the college received approval from the University of Calcutta in 1896 to initially offer Arts courses. For approximately 25 years, the college functioned as an intermediate college. In 1923, it obtained permission to teach the B.A. course. In 1956, the college became a government-sponsored institution, and the B.Sc. course was introduced in 1958.

Since the early sixties, the college began to offer Honours courses, gradually expanding its offerings. Currently, it has 15 departments in Arts, Science, and Commerce streams, which is a significant achievement for a college located in a rural area. The college has consistently aimed to promote the idea of inclusive and comprehensive education without compromising on quality, which has been its important vision since its inception.

Central Library with Digital Facilities





General Information

The Institute is governed by the rules and regulations laid down by the University of Burdwan.

• Class Attendance cum Internal Assessment (Semester Mode)

For B.A. & B.Com. (Hons. & Gen.) Courses, having no practical, the distribution of 75 marks is as follows:

20% of 75 marks = 15 marks, of which 5 marks are reserved for class attendance (both theoretical + tutorial) in the following manner:

Attendance 50% & above but below 60% - 2 marks

Attendance 60% & above but below 75% - 3 marks

Attendance 75% & above but below 90% - 4 marks

Attendance 90% & above - 5 marks

10 marks are reserved for class test/assignment/seminar (theoretical-5 & tutorial-5).

For B.Sc. (Hons. & Gen.) Courses, having practical, the distribution of 75 marks is as follows:

20% of 75 marks = 15 marks, of which 5 marks are reserved for theoretical class attendance in the following manner:

Attendance 50% & above but below 60% - 2 marks

Attendance 60% & above but below 75% - 3 marks

Attendance 75% & above but below 90% - 4 marks

Attendance 90% & above - 5 marks

10 marks are reserved for class test/assignment/seminar (theoretical-5 & practical-5).

Semester-end Examination

For B.A., B.Sc. & B.Com. (Hons. & Gen.), Major, Minor Courses, having no practical, the distribution of 75 marks is as follows:

In the Semester-end Examination of each course, the Question Paper is set for 60 marks, with the following distribution:

Answer 10 questions out of 15 carrying 02 marks each = $10 \times 02 = 20$

Answer 04 questions out of 06 carrying 05 marks each = $04 \times 05 = 20$

Answer 02 questions out of 04 carrying 10 marks each = $02 \times 10 = 20$

For B.Sc. (Hons. & Gen.), Courses, having practical, the distribution of 75 marks is as follows:

20 marks are allotted for Semester-end Practical Examination of each course, with

the following distribution:

Lab. Note Book: 05 Marks

Viva-voce: 05 Marks Experiment: 10 marks

Or, as may be decided by the concerned Board of Studies.

40 marks are allotted for Semester-end Theoretical Examination of each course, with the following distribution:

Answer 05 questions out of 08 carrying 02 marks each = $05 \times 02 = 10$

Answer 02 questions out of 04 carrying 05 marks each = $02 \times 05 = 10$

Answer 02 questions out of 04 carrying 10 marks each = $02 \times 10 = 20$

Major & Minor Courses (NEP), having practical of 20 marks is as follows:

Lab. Note Book: 05 Marks

Viva-voce: 05 Marks Experiment: 10 marks

Or, as may be decided by the concerned Board of Studies.

Major & Minor Courses (NEP), having practical of 40 marks is as follows:

Lab. Note Book: 05 Marks

Viva-voce: 10 Marks Experiment: 25 marks

Or, as may be decided by the concerned Board of Studies.

Major & Minor Courses (NEP), having practical of 60 marks is as follows:

Lab. Note Book: 05 Marks

Viva-voce: 20 Marks Experiment: 35 marks

Or, as may be decided by the concerned Board of Studies.

Note: Students who do not fulfill the required class attendance cum internal assessment will not be allowed to appear for the semester-end examinations.

- Promotion/Examination: Promotion is regulated by the University rules.
- Withdrawal: A student who wishes to leave the Institute must apply in writing to the Principal with his/her application countersigned by a guardian/parent. All fees, fines, and other dues will be charged up to the end of the Term in which the formal withdrawal takes place.
- Removal: The College Authority has the power to strike off the name of a student who is grossly irregular in attendance or is not amenable to Institute discipline.
- Identity Card: Since the entire college procedures are computerized, students are issued an ID card after admission. This card is valid for every year of study in the college and must be brought by the student every day. The college authority also provides a library card to students for issuing books from the library. The fee for the

Identity card is not refundable in case of withdrawal of admission.

- Discipline: Students are expected to respect the college rules and maintain discipline on the campus, both inside and outside the classrooms. Students must note the following:
 - (a) Cellular phones: Cellular phones must be switched off during classes. Cellular phones cannot be carried into the examination hall.
 - (b) Regularity: All students enrolled at the institute are pursuing a full-time course and are not allowed to undertake any unpaid or paid commitments/assignments outside the college.
 - (c) Ragging: Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within the premises of the college or any part of the University system or in public transport. Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging will be subject to disciplinary action as per University ordinance.
 - (d) Sexual Harassment: The Institute has constituted a Sexual Harassment Prevention Cell under the VISHAKHA guidelines of the Supreme Court of India for gender sensitization to address the issues of sexual harassment.
- Fines: The college believes that academics and co-curricular activities go hand in hand for the all-round development of the personality. Therefore, all students are required to be present for various events in the college. Students who absent themselves from the college on those days shall have to pay the stipulated fine. In case any student is sick, medical leave will be granted on the production of a medical certificate from a registered practitioner either before or on the day in question.
- Health: If any student suffers from a specific health problem or chronic health disorder, it needs to be conveyed to the Institute by the parents/guardians.
- Personal Belongings: Students are advised not to bring large sums of money, jewelry, or other valuables to the Institute. They should be careful about their personal belongings in the college. Attempts are made to return lost property if found by peons, cleaners, etc. However, the college takes no responsibility in the matter.
- Free-ships: The institute has provisions for granting free ship to students based on merit and means. Students desiring to avail free ship must collect the forms from the office and submit the completed forms.
- Educational Trip: Educational Trips/Study Tours/Excursions/Field studies are mandatory in the CBCS syllabus for all Honours students of Zoology, Botany, Geography, etc. All Honours students must participate in these trips. Students who absent themselves from these educational trips shall have to pay the stipulated fine. In case any student is sick, medical leave will be granted on the production of a medical certificate from a registered practitioner at least 7 days before the said program.





This manual is a step-by-step guidance to the students who will apply through this portal in the Undergraduate Courses in HEIs of the State of West Bengal.


